## **DUI School Registration Information**

---

The DUI School is often called the Counter Attack School or CAS. There are two levels of DUI School. Level I DUI School is 12 hours of classroom time plus a one-hour evaluation. Level I is for people with no prior DUI or reckless driving offenses. Level II DUI School is 21 hours of classroom time plus a one-hour evaluation.

## **Documentation Required when Enrolling in DUI School**

---

The Florida Safety Council will require you to have certain information before you can register for DUI school. The required information is listed below.

1. Your drivers' license number
2. Your complete arrest affidavit
3. A copy of your DUI citation
4. Your breath test results, urinalysis results, or refusal affidavit
5. Court disposition, pretrial diversion contract (if you have already appeared in court)
6. Picture ID—government issued, US passport, student ID, booking photo
7. Complete, official lifetime Florida driving record, can be purchased for \$15
