

BATTERERS INTERVENTION PROGRAM INFORMATION

You have been ordered to complete a Batterer's Intervention Program. It is VERY important that you successfully complete this program. Please enroll as soon as possible. DO NOT WAIT. DO NOT MISS classes because it could get you kicked out of Pre-trial diversion or have your probation violated—which will cause you to go to JAIL. If you are on probation, and violated for a reason other than BIP, keep going to your BIP classes!

If you need to miss a class, let your provider know WELL AHEAD OF TIME so they can make-up your missed class. If you become financially unable to pay at all, let your provider know in WRITING, and attempt to work out a payment plan in WRITING! Below are a list of approved providers that have provided us with this information.

Family Life Services: 407-518-9505; Kissimmee; Average 50 – 60 dollars

- 1 1/2 hour group for 26 weeks. Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, morning afternoon and evening. Timing is flexible if a client needs something else.
- \$150 entry fee
- Can start classes any time, before or after getting involved with court
- Payment plans are available. No weekly payments are required
- Can double up on classes
- Offers classes in Spanish

ACS Wellness Group, Inc.: 407-944-1155; Kissimmee; Average 10-30 dollars

- 1 ½ hour group for 26 weeks. Monday evenings, Wednesday mornings and Thursday evenings.
- \$50 initial fee, \$30 intake fee, \$30 orientation fee
- Can start classes any time but court order is preferred.
- Reduced fee available for indigent populations
- Pay per class
- No doubling up on classes
- Offers classes in Spanish

Resolution Counseling, Inc. / Abolish Abuse; 407-876-7757; Orlando; Average 35-60 dollars

- 1 ½ hour group for 26 weeks. Monday nights.
- \$65 fee for orientation and assessment.
- Can start classes after probation and/or injunction.
- Potentially reducing price if income is not high
- Pay per class
- No doubling up on classes
- Offers classes in Spanish

Beltran Behavioral Health: 407-518-9161; Kissimmee; Average 25-55 dollars

- 1 ½ hour group for 29 weeks. Female classes are on Tuesday afternoons and Male Spanish classes are on Tuesday afternoons. Male English classes are on Wednesday afternoons and evenings and Thursday evenings.
- \$10 fee for disability (if needed) and \$30 intake fee
- Need court order prior to beginning the program
- Pay per class
- If unemployed, show proof and payment gets reduced to \$20 per class for four weeks
- No doubling up on classes
- Offers classes in Spanish

A No Abuse Program, Inc.: 407-228-9503; Orlando, Average 25-70 dollars

- 1 ½ hour group for 26 weeks. English classes on Saturday mornings, Monday evenings, Tuesday mornings and evenings, Wednesday mornings and evenings. Spanish classes on Thursday evenings.
- \$20 enrollment fee
- Can start classes prior to having a court order
- Pay per class
- Financial assistance available with completion of Fee Reduction Request Form with proof of income
- No doubling up on classes
- **Offers classes in Spanish**

Change in Motion: 407-637-2633; Winter Park; Average 18 – 36.50 dollars

- 26 weeks. Saturday mornings, Monday evenings, Friday evenings.
- \$50 intake fee
- Can start classes before court order or conviction
- Pay per class
- Sliding scale financial assistance available with disability and/or unemployment paperwork
- Can double up on classes if probation and court agrees
- **Offers classes in Creole and Spanish**

All Family Resource Center: 321-206-6560; Kissimmee; Average 30 – 50 dollars

- 26 weeks. Saturday mornings and need to have orientation prior by appointment.
- \$60 assessment fee and \$35 orientation fee
- Can start while waiting on documentation required for this program like police reports, court documents
- Pay per class
- Financial assistance available to lower cost with court paperwork of indigence and proof of income
- No doubling up on classes

Central Florida Recovery Centers, Inc.: 407-370-5357 & 321-251-2251; Orlando; Average 50 dollars

- 1 ½ hour group for 29 weeks. Tuesday evenings and Thursdays midday.
- \$40 assessment fee, \$60 treatment plan fee; if drug screening is required, \$25 fee
- Can complete orientation whenever but cannot come for assessment until court order
- Pay per class
- No financial assistance
- No doubling up on classes

Families Against Abuse: 407-260-6343; Longwood & 2 Orlando locations; Average 30 – 70 dollars

- 26 weeks. Female classes on Thursday nights and Male classes on Wednesday nights, Tuesday nights, Thursday midday and evenings, and Saturday midday. Additional classes on appointment.
- \$20 entry fee
- Can start before involvement with court
- Pay per class
- ~~No financial assistance by free classes in Seminole County Jail; proof of income for sliding scale payment~~
- No doubling up
